## Why should you support the Young Women's Breast Cancer Program at Siteman Cancer Center?

- Of the 180,000 women who will be diagnosed with breast cancer in 2010, over 12% will be 44 or younger
- Young women have more aggressive breast cancer, e.g., larger tumor size, greater frequency of invasion and tumors that are often not responsive to hormonal therapies which limits their treatment options
- Women 44 or younger experience higher recurrence rates and the lowest 5-year and overall survival rates
- Young women live with this disease during the most demanding time of their lives, as they are raising children or starting a family, working full-time jobs and building their careers or providing care for their parents or elderly relatives
- The Young Women's Breast Cancer Program is dedicated to providing support, raising awareness and conducting research focused on this segment of breast cancer patients
